

**Ex-speaker appointed Sabah governor**

KOTA KINABALU – Juhar Mahiruddin succeeded Ahmadshah Abdullah as the 10th Sabah governor.

The former Sabah state assembly speaker took his oath in front of Chief judge of Sabah and Sarawak Richard Malanjum at Istana Negeri here Saturday.

Born on Nov 5, 1953, in Kampung Tambisan, Sandakan, Juhar who holds a bachelor's degree in law from the Wolverhampton Polytechnic in England, had served as a first-class magistrate from 1981 to 1982.

Juhar was appointed Sabah state assembly speaker in 2002 and held the position until his latest appointment today.

Ahmadshah's two-term as governor ended yesterday.
