SHAH ALAM -- The Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah said today he deeply regretted that his speeches have been manipulated by irresponsible groups to the extent that many of his subjects in Selangor have been confused.

"I wish to emphasise that the appointment of the Selangor State Secretary was made in accordance with regulations and procedures stipulated by the Selangor State Constitution and the Federal Constitution," the Ruler said.
