

PAS: PM Missed Funeral & Wake of fellow UMNO man during his visit to Tenang

Labis – Prime Minister Najib Razak’s whirlwind visit to Tenang days prior to nomination for the upcoming by-election was generally well received. It was so popular that an imam in charge of the funeral of the late UMNO branch secretary of Felda Tenang, Abdul Latif Subhi was claimed to be so caught up with the visit that he left his station to join in the welcoming ceremony for the PM.

Spokesperson from PAS claimed that they had to put political differences aside by bringing in people from Pahang to look into the funeral arrangements for the late UMNO strongman after the Zohor prayers. PAS candidate Normala Sudirman, better known as Cikgu Mala was present to give her condolences to the widow and family of the late Abdul Latif at the Felda mosque.

It was reported that the PM missed the wake and funeral although the body was situated in a mosque no more than 50 metres from the site where the welcoming ceremony was held.

Aside from being a Felda settler, the late Abdul Latif was the former Army MP and civil defence officer.

It is not known if the PM is aware of the departure of Abdul Latif.
