

**Opposition Leaders: We Are Ready For Polls**

KUALA LUMPUR -- Opposition party leaders said that they are ready to face the general election "at any time from now."

They made the declaration after a meeting chaired by Opposition Leader Anwar Ibrahim at his parliament office.

Top leaders of all parties in the opposition pact attended the meeting, including PAS president Abdul Hadi Awang and DAP advisor Lim Kit Siang.

Abdul Hadi told reporters that important matters concerning the interests of the opposition parties had been resolved, including the allocation of seats.

"Our preparations for the election will proceed as we discussed today," he said.

Abdul Hadi said that all preparations would be completed before the dissolution of the Sarawak legislative assembly, whose tenure expires on July 24.

The opposition parties were still asking the Election Commission to extend the campaign period from seven to 21 days.

"We also call for equal media access to all parties contesting in the general election," Abdul Hadi said.
