

**Dr M Expresses Regret Book Being Sold Twice The Price**

CYBERJAYA, -- Former prime minister Dr Mahathir Mohamad said that he was dismayed that his autobiography was being sold at twice its selling price.

"There are people who buy 15 copies...thereafter they sell them at RM200 each (the retail price is RM100 a copy)," he said while autographing copies of the book for buyers including journalists after giving a press conference following the launching Kumpulan Eskay's Lestari building here Wednesday

Dr Mahathir had launched his autobiography titled 'A Doctor in the House: The Memoirs of Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad' only last week.

He said there had already been calls for a reprint of the 800-page book.

Posed the question that the book was comparatively cheaper than Tom Plate's 248-page 'Conversations with Mahathir Mohamed' which was launched just two week ago and was retailing at RM79.90 a copy, Dr Mahathir said, "It's okay...let people have a chance to read it."
