

Najib - No Police Involvement In Sex Video Recording

KUALA LUMPUR -- Najib Tun Razak confirmed Home Minister Hishammuddin Hussein's statement that police were not involved in the recording of a sex video allegedly involving an opposition leader.

The prime minister said this in his Twitter posting on Monday night.

Hishammuddin had earlier said that the police were not involved in the video recording of a sex act allegedly involving a prominent opposition leader with an unknown woman, as revealed by the media.

He also said that so far, there had been no police report lodged on the video.

An unidentified group had claimed that it was in possession of a black-and- white video clip showing the sexual act involving the opposition leader with a female prostitute at a hotel here that offered sexual services.

The group, led by a person who identified himself only as Datuk T, said it would hand over the tape to the opposition leader and his wife within a week.
