

PAS Condemns Dirty Politics

KUALA LUMPUR -- PAS has described the exposure of the pornographic video involving an opposition leader with a prostitute yesterday as a dirty political gimmick in the run up to the Sarawak state election.

PAS president Abdul Hadi Awang, who is also the Marang Member of Parliament, said that according to Islamic teachings, any allegation involving a person's integrity and morals should be rejected if there were doubts in the allegation.

Abdul Hadi said this to reporters at the office of the Opposition Leader at Parliament House which was also attended by Anwar Ibrahim, DAP Advisor Lim Kit Siang, and several other members of the opposition pact.

"There will be doubts if the report does not have actual details, that's why Islam makes it compulsory for an accusation to be supported by four credible and fair witnesses.

"It must be ascertained who the cameraman is, how is the recording device installed, the actual actors, the producer...do they have any stupid and malicious elements or lies. If any of these elements are present, then it is not fit to be a correct information," he said.

On Monday, a group led by a man introducing himself only as 'Datuk T' claimed that they had a black and white video clip showing a leader of the opposition having sex with a woman prostitute at a hotel, here which offered sexual services.
