

"Datuk T" Revealed

KUALA LUMPUR -- Businessman Shazryl Eskay Abdullah owned up today as the mystery man who screened for selected journalists on Monday a sex video allegedly involving an opposition leader.

He also said that the "T" in the identification "Datuk T" he had used stood for "trio", meaning him and two other people whom he identified as former Melaka Chief Minister Abdul Rahim Thamby Chik and Shuib Lazim, treasurer of the Malay right-wing group, Perkasa.

Shazryl Eskay made the revelation at a media conference held at a hotel here, at which Abdul Rahim was present but not Shuib. The businessman had screened the sex video for the journalists at the Carcosa Seri Negara hotel on Monday.

Opposition Leader Anwar Ibrahim, who is Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) advisor, denied on Monday itself that he was the man in the sex video and claimed that it was yet another conspiracy to malign him and his family and tarnish his political career.

At today's news conference, Shazryl Eskay and Abdul Rahim reiterated Shazryl's call on Monday for the setting up of a commission to investigate the video clip in which a man resembling an opposition leader is involved in a sexual act with a woman said to be a prostitute.

In PETALING JAYA, Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) MP for Sungai Petani Johari Abdul said today a sex video allegedly involving an opposition leader was screened for him to watch at a hotel in Ampang, Selangor on Monday.

He claimed that Shazryl Eskay Abdullah and Abdul Rahim Thamby Chik arranged the screening of the video for him.

Johari told a news conference at the PKR headquarters here that he was invited by his uncle Shuib Lazim, the Sungai Petani Umno Division chief, to watch the video.

"I met him (Shuib) at the De Palma Hotel. We were taken in a car to Flamingo Hotel where we were brought to a Junior Suite and I met Abdul Rahim and Shazryl Eskay," he said.

Johari said that during the video presentation, Shazryl Eskay made some remarks on several matters with Abdul Rahim intervening now and then.

He said that after watching the video, he expressed his willingness to bring along several PKR MPs to watch the video and meet Abdul Rahim.

"I was informed that the video will be screened again at 3.30pm yesterday. We waited at the Flamingo Hotel until 5.30pm but the meeting was called off by them," he said.

Meanwhile, PAS secretary-general Saifuddin Nasution claimed that an Umno divisional deputy chief had booked the room at the Carcosa Seri Negara hotel where the sex video was screened to selected journalists.

Opposition Leader and PKR advisor Anwar Ibrahim lodged a police report at the Dang Wangi district police headquarters yesterday after denying on Monday that he was the man in the sex video.
