

Don't Speculate On Sex Video

KUALA LUMPUR -- Information Communication and Culture Minister Dr Rais Yatim today called on the people to refrain from any form of speculation over the emergence of a sex video allegedly involving an opposition politician.

He said no one should make unfounded allegations at this time and should leave the matter for the police to investigate.

"The investigation has to be thorough. We should wait. We cannot speculate and take advantage of the situation to fish in troubled waters," he told reporters at the lobby of Parliament.

Commenting on the sex video, Dr Rais said those involved should lodge a police report to facilitate an investigation to clear their name.

Businessman Shazryl Eskay Abdullah owned up today as the mystery man who had screened the sex video for selected journalists.

He had also that the "T" in the identification "Datuk T" he had used stood for "trio", meaning him and two other people whom he identified as former Melaka Chief Minister Abdul Rahim Thamby Chik and Shuib Lazim, treasurer of the Malay right-wing group, Perkasa.
