

Nazri Asked To Self Reflect On Remarks Or Join DAP

KUALA LUMPUR - MCA's Loh Seng Kok said that Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Nazri Aziz should realise that his opinions do not reflect the overall views of the vast majority of UMNO and the Malay community.

"Neither Nazri, UMNO nor PAS spiritual leader Nik Aziz may claim to wield the entire authority on Islam as many Malays support different political parties including multi-racial political parties." Loh said in a statement issued to Malaysian Mirror.

"Since Nazri feels strongly against MCA representing the Chinese community, similarly Nazri does not represent UMNO, and UMNO does not represent all Malays because PKR and PAS have a foothold in Malay-dominant electorates also."

The MCA Central Committee member further suggested to Nazri to join DAP "which claims to be a multi-racial based political party but yet does not have sufficient Malay influence."

MCA took a further swipe at DAP and asked Lim Guan Eng to vacate his position as DAP Secretary General and hand it over to Nazri since Lim had earlier praised Nazri as "respectable" and someone who represents all races.

Loh said that Nazri's merciless attacks against a fellow component party would enable the Opposition to seize on the opportunity to undermine BN's unity and harmony.

"When political leaders point their finger at another, be mindful that 4 fingers are aimed back at oneself. Nazri should review his own statement because not only is he banging his own head against the wall, but (he has) completely miscomprehend UMNO's and BN's structure." he said.
