

Najib Meets SCA Leaders

KUCHING -- Prime Minister Najib Tun Razak on Wednesday held a meeting with leaders of the Sarawak Churches Association (SCA).

The one-hour meeting was held at a leading hotel here.

The association's secretary-general Ambrose Linang said at the meeting, Najib explained about the controversy that erupted following bibles in Bahasa Malaysia being held up at Kuching Port and Port Klang and the steps the government took to resolve it.

"We were pleased to have the dialogue with Najib which was conducted in a harmonious atmosphere.

"As the representatives of Christians in Sarawak, we appreciate the action taken by the government in resolving the matter," he said when contacted by Bernama.

Ambrose said the meeting had nothing to do with this Saturday's Sarawak state election and that the prime minister did not touch on political matters.

According to him, the Christian leaders were very happy that Najib was willing to meet them, as this was the first time a prime minister held discussions with the association.

"What is important is the outcome (of the meeting), the prime minister wants to see the existing harmony in Sarawak preserved and that there should be no wedge that could disrupt this (harmony)," he said.
