

RPK Admission Exposes "Chief Conspirator"

KUALA LUMPUR -- The admission by Malaysia Today blogsite operator Raja Petra Kamaruddin on an attempt to implicate the prime minister and his wife Rosmah Mansor in Mongolian Altantuya Shaariibuu's murder is said to have clearly indicated who the "chief conspirator" really was.

Anuar Shaari, former private secretary to PKR de facto leader Anwar Ibrahim, said it clearly showed who had actually conspired to implicate Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and his wife in the murder.

"Raja Petra has exposed the individuals who had associations with an opposition leader, said to be the one behind the conspiracy so as to prevent Najib from becoming prime minister," he said to Bernama, here, today.

In last night's TV3 news broadcast, Raja Petra revealed that his statutory statement made in 2008 which linked Najib to Altantuya's murder in 2006 was based on information and goading from certain individuals who did not wish to see Najib, who was then deputy prime minister, become prime minister.

Raja Petra said he himself had not accused Najib or Rosmah of being involved in the Mongolian woman's murder and he no longer believed the stories of the individuals said to associate with several political leaders including Anwar.

Anuar said Raja Petra's admission was shocking and he believed that the opposition leader would not dare file a defamation suit against Raja Petra.
