

**Anwar: Comments On RPK Only After Sarawak Polls**

KUCHING -- Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) advisor Anwar Ibrahim said today that he will only comment on remarks made about his leadership by Malaysia-Today editor Raja Petra Kamaruddin after the Sarawak state election tomorrow.

The Opposition leader said he was not trying to skirt the issue but preferred to give his answer on Sunday.

"This is to avoid attention from being diverted from the (Sarawak) election," he reporters here.

Anwar had been asked to comment on remarks made by Raja Petra, more popularly known as RPK, that Anwar had lost credibility as a leader.

The blogger had said this in an exclusive interview with TV3 group editor Ashraf Abdullah in Perth, Australia recently, which was aired on the TV station's prime news last night.
