

**Perkasa Wants Chinese, Indians To View Its Struggle Positively**

ALOR SETAR -- The Malay right-wing group Perkasa wants the Chinese and Indians to view its struggle in defending the rights of the Malays from a positive angle.

Kedah Perkasa president Syed Osman Mansor said yesterday Perkasa would defend the rights of the Malays in accordance with the law and there was nothing secret to its struggle.

"The Malays have become disunited because of politics. Nevertheless, a rise in their unity was seen through two huge gatherings (organised by Perkasa) in Pasir Mas, Kelantan, and Pasir Salak, Perak, this year.

"Kedah Perkasa will organise the third gathering at the Sultan Abdul Halim Stadium here on Friday and Saturday," he told reporters.

Syed Osman said more than 30,000 people were expected at the gathering.

He said Perkasa would launch the "1Bumi, 1Melayu" campaign on Saturday to openly demand Malay rights.
