

PAS Sticks With Pakatan

KOTA BAHARU -- PAS spiritual leader Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat said PAS will not leave the Pakatan coalition despite the Prime Minister Najib Tun Razak's call to the party to do so.

"This (leaving Pakatan) is an old issue," Nik Aziz, who is also Kelantan Menteri Besar, told reporters after opening a mosque building programme here on Saturday.

Speaking in Kuala Terengganu earlier yesterday, Najib had said only the DAP was benefiting in the Pakatan coalition and that PAS would not be able to champion Islam with the DAP as its partner.

As such, Najib said PAS would be better off exiting the opposition coalition.

Najib also said Malaysia's future was more assured under the leadership of the Barisan Nasional and Umno.
