

Existing Govt Upholds Peace, Says Muhyiddin

KANGAR -- The existing government in the country discharges its responsibilities in bringing progress and maintaining peace in the country in a trustworthy manner, said Muhyiddin Yassin.

The Deputy Prime Minister said this had been going on for a long time and not within the past year and, as such, it must be preserved by the people in the country.

In addition, he said, the country's leadership had the ability and determination to fulfill the people's aspirations to the extent that Malaysia had been recognised as a model of a developing nation by other countries.

"The government generates considerable revenue which can be utilised...if there are problems, they are resolved. This is a blessing that we must protect.

Don't destroy the foundations of development that we have built all this time.

"Let us not destroy the development that we have achieved all this while because of political agendas. This occurs widely such as in the Middle East," he said in his speech at the Nurul Hikmah Mosque, Wang Bintong, here yesterday.

Also present were Perlis Menteri Besar Dr Md Isa Sabu, the Member of Parliament for Kangar Radzi Sheikh Ahmad and Perlis Mufti Dr Juanda Jaya.

Muhyiddin said currently there were Western communities labelling Islam as "terrorists" to the extent that it had created a situation of 'Islamophobia' and this was not a good example.

"A good example is in Malaysia. The Umno leadership is 100 per cent Muslims. We have done this for many years. We should preserve this," he said.

He said the government had given focus on the economy all this while although the social aspect was also emphasised to create a healthy and prosperous environment.

Muhyiddin performed the Maghrib and Isyak prayers at the mosque.
