

DAP Challenged To Leave Opposition Pact

BAGAN DATOH - Umno vice-president Ahmad Zahid Hamidi has challenged DAP to leave the opposition pact and face the general election alone.

He said by contesting on its own ticket without PKR and PAS, DAP could test its strength and support among the people.

"I dare DAP to do this and be a man," he told reporters after presenting 1Malaysia laptop computers to 2,876 secondary school students in Bagan Datoh parliamentary constituency on Tuesday.

He was commenting a statement by DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng that the party is against having the general election this year even if the federal government decides to call for it.

The Defence Minister said the DAP statement was politically motivated to seek cheap publicity.
