

Divisions Must Fulfill All Promises Made During 12th GE, Says Muhyiddin

KUALA LUMPUR -- Umno Deputy President Muhyiddin Yassin wants all Umno divisions in the country to ensure that all promises made during the last general election are fulfilled.

Muhyiddin who is also the Deputy Prime Minister said promises that have yet to be fulfilled must be given due consideration, no matter how big the promises were.

"Efforts must be taken to settle issues at the division level. There might be some promises made during the general election that have not been fulfilled.

No matter how big the promise, it cannot be neglected," he said when opening the Wangsa Maju delegates meeting here yesterday.

"Apart from fulfilling promises, we must also carry out programmes that can cater for the people's need. It is important to ensure such issues will not hinder Umno's campaign ahead of the 13th general election."

He added that if the promises had been fulfilled, then focus should be on strengthening the party at the divisional level.

The relationship between divisional leaders and members must be good and strong to make sure the stability of the party continues.

"There must be no conflict within the Umno divisions. Relationship must be good and harmonious at all levels. Issues should not derail our election machinery when campaigning," he said.

Muhyiddin said the Umno machinery must work extra hard because the opposition would not easily forego the seats that they have won in the past election.

"Furthermore, since the opposition has been ruling some states, they (opposition) will continue to strengthen their position. They have strategies and go down to the grassroots to implement programmes for the people. Steps that we take, they too have taken and may be more than us," he said.

Meanwhile, Muhyiddin also allocated an initial fund of RM1 million to the Wangsa Maju Umno division to assist nine Indian temples and 27 Chinese temples in the division, headed by Mohd Shafie Abdullah.

Muhyiddin said the allocation was to assist the places of worship that needed repairs.
