KUANTAN -- PAS should apologise to Umno for making wild allegations against the party ever since its establishment before changing its struggle to set up a welfare state

Pasir Gudang Member of Parliament Mohamed Khaled Nordin said the PAS leaders had passed various accusations at Umno, including labelling the party an infidel, for not setting up an Islamic state.

"PAS should apologise to Umno because when their struggle was for Islam, they accused Umno of doing things wrong, but recently they said the struggle to set up an Islamic state is not in the Quran, but a welfare state," he told reporters after opening an entrepreneurial festival at the Kuantan Community College here today.

PAS president, Abdul Hadi Awang , in his speech at the party's annual assembly last week, said that PAS was focusing on welfare state because it was similar with what was being pursued by its allies in the opposition pact.

Hadi also said that there was no mention of an Islamic state in the Quran.

Mohamed Khaled, who is Higher Education Minister, said PAS had also caused the people, especially the Malays, to split.

He advised the people not to be deceived by PAS whose leaders would do anything for power.
