

Dr M Declines Comment On KJ's Twitter Statement

PUTRAJAYA -- Langkawi International Dialogue (LID) founder Dr Mahathir Mohamad is unperturbed by Umno Youth chief Khairy Jamaluddin Abu Bakar's statement that such dialogue should be done away with.

"People always have different opinions. They are entitled to their opinions. Other people are entitled to their opinions," he told Bernama today.

The former prime minister was asked to comment on the statement which appeared on Khairy's Twitter last night.

The statement was as follows: "(Zimbabwe President) Robert Mugabe arrived in Malaysia. What do we gain by inviting a leader like this? It has been sometime...need to halt such dialogue."

Dr Mahathir was met after the official opening of the LID 2011 by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak at the Putrajaya International Convention Centre here.
