

Commission Report On Teoh's Death Handed Over To Agong

KUALA LUMPUR -- The Royal Commission of Inquiry (RCI) into the death of political aide Teoh Beng Hock on Wednesday handed over its 124-page report to Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin at Istana Terengganu here.

Commission secretary Saripuddin Kasim said the report was handed to the King at 10.30 am and the commission would hold a press conference at the Jalan Duta Court Complex later.

The Commission was headed by Federal Court judge James Foong Cheng Yuen.

The other members of the RCI were Federal Court judge Datuk Abdul Kadir Sulaiman, former Appeals Court judge Datuk T.S.Nathan, Penang Hospital's forensic pathology consultant Datuk Dr Bhupinder Singh, and forensic psychiatric consultant and dean of the Medical Faculty of Cyberjaya University College of Medical Sciences, Prof Dr Mohamed Hatta Shaharom.

The setting up of the RCI was announced on Jan 26 by Prime Minister Najib Tun Razak to investigate the cause of Teoh's death after the coroner returned an open verdict.
