

DPM Urge Malay Contractors To Create Their Own Chances

KUALA LUMPUR -- Deputy Prime Minister Muhyiddin Yassin yesterday urged Malay contractors to create their own opportunities to be involved in achieving government targets.

He said they should identify new areas and markets for themselves and be bold in diversifying their business.

"The government has drawn up various transformation programmes to turn Malaysia into a developed nation and to make it more competitive in the region and globally.
