

Perkasa To Cancel Gathering If Illegal Assembly Is Called Off

KUALA LUMPUR -- The Malay right-wing group, Perkasa, said on Monday that it will give up its plan to hold a gathering on July 9 if the organiser of an illegal assembly to be held on that date is prepared to do the same.

Perkasa president Ibrahim Ali said the group would not prohibit its members from holding a gathering if the illegal assembly went ahead as planned.

He spoke to reporters after briefing the police on the planned Perkasa gathering at the Dang Wangi district police headquarters here.

Ibrahim arrived at the police headquarters at about noon with several Perkasa members and briefed the police for about two hours.

He said Perkasa wanted to hold its gathering to show that the public did not support the illegal assembly.
