

**BN Always Leaves It To The People To Decide Its Fate, Says Najib**

KOTA KINABALU -- Najib Tun Razak said the Barisan Nasional (BN) always left to the people to decide its fate each time it faces the opposition in elections.

The Prime Minister said the BN believed that the people would make a wise choice through the election process and not through illegal street demonstrations like those planned for July 9 by a trouble-maker group.

"When the time comes (for a general election), the BN is prepared to take on the opposition and leave its fate in the hands of the people...not resort to street demonstrations," he told a crowd of some 10,000 people who turned up for a 1Malaysia dinner at Padang Merdeka here last night.

Najib said the BN did not want to win elections through cheating but instead was ready to face "whatever the opposition could throw at it" in facing an election.

He said if elections in the country were not clean, it would have been impossible for the coalition to lose several states and two-thirds majority in Parliament in the last general election.

Najib said he was confident that the people of Sabah, who he described as shining examples of the 1Malaysia concept, would object to illegal street demonstrations hatched by people with vested interests.

He said the racial harmony enjoyed by the people, particularly in saba should not be taken for granted as illegal street demonstrations like the ones planned by the trouble-maker group could put paid to the existing harmony in "blink of the eye".

Najib said he was also confident that Sabah would remain in the hands of the BN following the next general election.

This was because the BN had brought tremendous development for the people of Sabah, he said

On the 1Malaysia concept, the prime minister stressed the need to have policies and systems that were fair under the principle of inclusiveness and social justice for all Malaysians.
