

**King's View On Rally Timely And Most Welcomed, Says Malaysian Bar**

KUALA LUMPUR -- Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin's statement that street demonstrations bring more bad than good to the country, was timely and most welcomed, the Malaysian Bar said.

Its president Lim Chee Wee said all parties should consider the advice of the King and "replace any sledgehammer in one's hand with an olive branch instead."

However the Bar wants the police to charge the detained activists in court rather than detaining them under the Emergency Ordinance, he said in a statement today.

Tuanku Mizan in a special statement issued by Istana Negara on Sunday reminded all parties not to follow too much the practices in other countries, as harmony and stability are vital foundations for a country and which all quarters must protect.
