

**Bersih 2.0 Leaders Granted Audience with Agong**

Bersih 2.0 chief, Ambiga Sreenevasan, was seen entering the gates of the Istana Negara slightly before 2.00pm today. She was accompanied by Zaid Kamaruddin and national laureate A. Samad Said.

They were believed to have been granted an audience with the King, following their request yesterday. It is likely that they will share the movement's intention and position, as well as obtain any advice from the ruler on the controversial rally scheduled to take place on the 9th of this month.

This is the latest of a series of event that occurred following the issuance of a Royal statement urging the government to run the country in a "just and wise manner", and at the same time said that street demonstrations may be destructive despite its good intentions.

Earlier, Pakatan leaders from PAS, DAP and PKR signed a declaration that they are "open" to Prime Minister, Najib Razak's suggestion to hold the rally in a stadium instead. This point was earlier supported by former Perlis mufti and religious scholar, Asri Zainul Abidin.
