

Abdullah Deny Attempted Bribe Report By Aussie Newspaper

KUALA LUMPUR -- Abdullah Ahmad Badawi on Tuesday denied allegation of an attempted bribe when he was the prime minister and finance minister in 2003 as reported by an Australian newspaper.

"There is no truth whatsoever in the allegation as I cannot possibly remember of anyone approaching me with any offer.

"If indeed there was any, I would have unhesitatingly lodged an immediate report to the regulatory authorities including the police for the necessary follow-up action," Abdullah said in a statement here.

The Age Newspaper reported yesterday that a banknote firm are suspected of attempting to bribe Abdullah in order to get his help to win a A\$31 million currency contract.
