

Perkasa Wants To Hold Rally In Stadium, Have Audience With King

KUALA LUMPUR -- The Malay right-wing movement Perkasa said on Wednesday it would go ahead with its rally scheduled for July 9, but in a stadium, and that it was seeking an audience with the Yang di-Pertuan Agong.

Its president, Ibrahim Ali, said the movement had applied to have the rally at the Merdeka Stadium, Stadium Negara or Titiwangsa Stadium.

"We have applied for the police permit and sent applications to the stadiums concerned," he told reporters after a meeting of the Perkasa supreme council, here.

He said Perkasa had also sought an audience with the Yang di-Pertuan Agong to explain the current situation and obtain the advice of the king.

Ibrahim, who is the Pasir Mas MP, said Perkasa had also sought a meeting with Prime Minister Najib Tun Razak, either today or the day after.
