

**10 Detained For Disrupting Campaign Launch**

KUALA LUMPUR -- Police detained seven men and three women on Wednesday when they tried to disrupt the launch of the "Fly the Jalur Gemilang" campaign by Prime Minister Najib Tun Razak at KL Sentral here.

Kuala Lumpur Crime Investigation Chief Ku Chin the 10, wearing yellow T-shirts without any wording, were chanting "reformasi" when they were arrested at about 4pm.

The arrest followed a report by Brickfields District Police chief ACP Wan Abdul Bari Wan Abdul Khalid that a group of youths dressed in yellow would be creating a disturbance, he said in a statement.

He said that those detained would be released after police have recorded their statements.
