

Steer Clear From Politics, Mosque Committees Told

KLANG -- Sultan of Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah has reminded mosque committees not to allow mosques in the state to be used for political purposes.

He said they should adhere to the rulings made by Selangor Islamic Religious Council and the Selangor Islamic Religious Department (Jais).

"That is why those who wish to become religious inspectorates, imams and preachers must obtain credentials from Jais," he said when opening the At-Taqwa Mosque in Kampung Bukit Kapar here yesterday.

On the Warrior's Day, Sultan Sharafuddin reminded the people to appreciate the sacrifices made by soldiers in maintaining security, peace and harmony in the country.

The At-Taqwa Mosque was first built in 1969 before it was rebuilt at the cost of RM6.4 million to accommodate bigger congregators in 2007 and was completed on in September 2009.
