

Selangor MB To Seek Sultan's Advice Over Church Incident

SHAH ALAM -- Selangor Menteri Besar Abdul Khalid Ibrahim said on Friday he would obtain the advice of the Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, over the controversy of a raid by the Selangor Islamic Religious Affairs Department (Jais) at a goodwill dinner at the Damansara Utama Methodist Church on Wednesday.

He said he would present a Jais report on the matter to the ruler, but did not say when he would have the audience with the sultan.

Measures would be taken to ensure that the incident was not repeated after the audience with the sultan, he said in a statement.

Until then, he prohibited any Selangor state executive councillor from issuing any statement on the issue, he said.

Selangor Islamic Affairs, Malay Customs, Infrastructure and Public Amenities Committee chairman Hassan Mohd Ali said on Thursday that Jais conducted a check after being informed that Muslims were present at the event at the church.
