

Ramadan Best Time To Foster Unity, Says Muhyiddin

PUTRAJAYA -- Deputy Prime Minister Muhyiddin Yassin told Muslims on Sunday that Ramadan is the best occasion to strengthen unity among themselves while avoiding straining relations with the other communities.

He said that politics should not be allowed to damage relations between races and especially among Muslims.

"We are blessed because Muslims in the country can live in a good atmosphere and are able to foster solidarity.

"This is so although we might have felt of late that conditions in the country were sometimes worrying with relations with the other communities beginning to seem strained," he said at the breaking of fast at the Bestari orphanage here.

Muhyiddin said that such straining of relations must be resisted because it could lead to a host of problems.

He said the country was fortunate to have many generous individuals and corporations ready to donate to orphans and the poor.

"This shows that the benefits of development and what we have achieved can be shared with the needy of society," he said.

Muhyiddin later presented Hari Raya money to 67 orphans.
