

Report To Jais Any Deviant Teachings Or Movements, Says Selangor Sultan

KUALA LUMPUR -- The Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah has reminded the mosque committee members in Selangor to be aware of any deviant teachings and movements in the state.

He said the mosque committee members should immediately report the matter to the Selangor Islamic Religious Department (Jais) for further action, if they spotted anything suspicious.

"I do not want the elements of this heresy to occur and grow in this state," he said when opening the Seri Melati Mosque at Taman Seri Melati, Gombak here yesterday.

He also reminded the mosque committees not to allow mosques in the state to be used for any political purpose.

At the event, he also presented Hari Raya contributions to 400 people, comprising the poor, orphans and new converts, before breaking fast with the locals.
