

DAP's Assurance On Hudud Is Ineffective And Untrustworthy

The words of DAP Secretary-General Lim Guan Eng claiming that hudud laws are not part of Pakatan's election agenda are empty talk, and completely meaningless.

This is because in the previous general elections, PAS said nothing about achieving an Islamic state and implementing Islamic laws, but today they are now publicly announcing their plans of establishing and implementing an Islamic theocratic state.

I do not see the point of their announcement that hudud laws are not a part of the Pakatan agenda in the coming general elections as PAS has already declared their determination to implement hudud, ignoring Karpal Singh's opposition to their plans.
