

DAP Cannot Reach An Agreement Over Many Issues

There are many issues where DAP is unable to reach a consensus with each other and neither do they agree to each other's policies in Pakatan Rakyat.

1. DAP's Publicity chief Tony Pua said that if Pakatan Rakyat takes over the federal government, they will reduce the number of civil servants. However, when the Perak government decided to hand over the state's water company to the federal government in order to cover its partial debts and to reduce its debt from RM970.59 million to RM78.66 million, Setiawan assemblyman Ngeh Koo Ham criticized the Perak state government. Thus, what is DAP's real stand on this issue?

3. Lim Guan Eng had said that BN's cyber troopers will make the upcoming 13th General Elections the dirtiest election ever in the history of Malaysia, but the fact is that DAP has been banking on the cyber world all this while. Furthermore, DAP leaders are the ones who use foul language to curse others. Therefore, how 'clean' can their tactics be?

4. Many DAP leaders had objected to the 6% telecommunication charge by service providers being charged to consumers instead. After the government's discussions with the telco service providers, the telco service providers decided to absorb it. However, Pakatan Rakyat's Buku Jingga and its alternative budget made no mention on the cancellation of the telecommunication charges to consumers. This shows that DAP is cheating the voters.
