

MCA Will Quit BN If Umno Implements Hudud

On news reports that the Terengganu Menteri Besar Ahmad Said had said that the Terengganu state government will implement hudud law when the suitable time comes (China Press, 7 Dec '11), I hereby reiterate the stand taken by MCA as announced by party President Dr Chua Soi Lek i.e. if UMNO implements Hudud law, MCA will quit Barisan Nasional.

MCA's position against hudud law remains unshaken all this while, and we will never negotiate with any parties. Malaysia is a multiracial country. Implementation of hudud law will definitely affect non-Muslims. As pointed out by the speakers at the MCA-organised public forum on Hudud and its Implications on non-Muslims in Malaysia, hudud law will be applied to all irrespective of religion, although the weight of the witnesses' evidences differs between Muslims and non-Muslims. Hudud law divides and impacts negatively against the entire society. Therefore, it is not suitable to be implemented in Malaysia.

The MCA Exco in the Terengganu state Government, Toh Chin Yaw has also clarified his stand whereby he strongly objects against the implementation of Hudud law in Terengganu.

On the other hand, once again, I repeat my party's challenge to DAP whereby the Rocket needs to have a specific stand to answer to Malaysia's non-Muslim communities: When PAS insists on implementing hudud law, DAP keeps using the excuse that Pakatan partners will solve the matter.

There is a necessity for Lim Guan Eng to answer the two questions posed by MCA, which are, "How will DAP ensure that non-Muslims will not be affected by the implementation of hudud law" and "Will the implementation of hudud law being negative impact to the nation's economy, social, politics and education." If DAP is unable to give a clear reply to the two questions, DAP therefore cannot escape from the fact that they indirectly are supporting hudud law. Although DAP does not officially recognize hudud law, the Rocket still assists PAS to garner voter support during election campaigns. These actions indirectly will help the growth of PAS to wield more authority to implement hudud law.
