

**A Vote For DAP Is A Vote For PAS**

DAP parliamentary leader Lim Kit Siang's claim that "a vote for DAP is not a vote for PAS, but a vote for Pakatan Rakyat" is merely word play and makes no sense as it is only seen as an attempt to confuse the public by using their upside down logic to hide the fact that DAP is an accomplice to the implementation of Islamic theocracy and hudud law.

Both DAP and PAS are allied together in the Pakatan Rakyat coalition, and therefore a vote for DAP is akin to a vote for PAS which advocates the implementation of hudud law. Lim Kit Siang claims that a vote for DAP does not mean a vote for PAS, but on the other hand, they campaign for PAS candidates during by-elections and PAS is slowly trying to implement its Islamic policies in the states under Pakatan Rakyat. Therefore, Lim Kit Siang's call for the Chinese community to support PAS is nothing but a shameless two-faced behavior.
