

Voters Should Not Allow PR To Take Over Negeri Sembilan

DAP Secretary-General Lim Guan Eng has become extremely arrogant when he said that Pakatan Rakyat will take over the state government of Negeri Sembilan in the coming 13th General Elections even though the Prime Minister has not even announced the dissolution of Parliament.
