

MCA Denies Links With Beta Tegap S/B

KUALA LUMPUR - MCA President Dr Chua Soi Lek today said that the Party is not involved in the company that was given the contract for the Automated Enforcement System (AES), which is a computerised traffic summons system by the Road Transport Department.

In a statement to Malaysian Mirror, Chua said that the allegation by The Edge business weekly that Beta Tegap Sdn Bhd is linked to the MCA is both wrong and malicious.

"I would like to stress that it is not a company related to MCA and neither have I heard of this company."

He further urged the contractor, Beta Tegap Sdn Bhd to come forward to clear the air on the matter as soon as possible.

"The Road Transport Department should also reveal the date of the contract awarded to Beta Tegap and other necessary details to avoid any further confusion and misunderstanding." he added.
