

No Big Brother Relationship In Pakatan?

The imposition of PAS hudud law and amending the Federal Constitution from Islam as the religion of the federation to read that Islam is Addin (way of life) which will impact the rights and personal freedoms of Malaysians is imminent.

News Straits Times (12 May 2012) reported that PAS Dewan Ulama chief Harun Taib had said "we will implement hudud and amend the Constitution even if (it is) not with the current partners we have in Pakatan ... may be there will be other pacts (Pakatan) that will lend us their support... PAS will always be behind Hadi."

Harun gives full backing to Hadi's remarks on amending the Constitution to include Addin in the latter's capacity as party President. Paradoxically, the Dewan Ulama chief singles out Karpal's objection as a "personal opinion."

Why does Harun downgrade Karpal's party chairmanship to a lower domain of "personal opinion", thereby denying him the equivalent status to PAS' President Hadi.

This proves that DAP stalwart Lim Kit Siang's remarks that "there is no big brother relationship in Pakatan" is coined none other than to manipulate Chinese and non-Muslim voters into believing that DAP can represent their interest when the Rocket is unable to, or that PAS cares for them when it clearly does not.

To win office, Kit Siang along with DAP Secretary General Lim Guan Eng and all other DAP echelon deliberately negate informing Malaysian minorities what PAS is now openly declaring that implementation of hudud and Addin is inevitable if PAS obtained more seats than DAP or PKR, "if we have enough majority (of seats), if PAS is stronger than our allies, we will definitely implement (hudud and the amendment to the Constitution).

Harun's comments are precise signs that PAS has never and will never waver from their goal to pursue theocratic rule even on non-Muslims.

What is more exasperating which DAP is ignorant about is that, while happy to corral the votes for PAS, DAP cannot see that it is being used by its hardline ally which will soon abandon the Rocket. Thus, the rights of all DAP supporters once PAS secures power and amends the Constitution are trampled.

Even if the Rocket is not blind, it is unable to do anything, because it is already subdued to PAS.
