

DAP Should Practice Transparency Over Kickback Claims

Nibong Tebal MP Tan Tee Beng, who had lodged a MACC report over this issue, had claimed that this corrupt practice has been going on for the past three years and had brought in RM18,000 to her special assistant, Chan Huan Guan.

As of yet, there has been no proper explanation and no account reports by them. Teo Nie Ching's only claim to innocence is that the MACC has not called her even though a report has been lodged against her.

She should not be acting smug and claim innocence simply because the MACC had yet to call her over this issue.

All this while, Teo Nie Ching has always questioned the credibility of the MACC, claiming that any investigation by them would favour BN leaders.
