

"Agreeing To Disagree" Cannot Prevent Enforcement Of Hudud

DAP has found itself in a spot regarding the PAS hudud law issue. Lim Guan Eng had said that he will not support a theocratic nation and hudud, but his remarks were immediately rebutted by PAS leaders. PAS Youth chief Nasrudin Hassan has insisted in Harakah that implementing hudud law is the ultimate goal of PAS.
