

Dr M receives honorary doctorate

BATU PAHAT. Sat. — Former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad today received an honorary doctorate in technology management from Kolej Universiti Teknologi Tun Hussein Onn (KUiTTHO).

Chancellor Tunku Ibrahim Ibni Sultan Iskandar presented the doctorate to Dr Mahathir at the college's fourth convocation ceremony as a gesture of appreciation for his deeds in developing the country.

In his speech, Dr Mahathir said he was honoured to be awarded the doctorate.
