

Abdullah has 11 outstanding summonses

KUALA LUMPUR: Er ... excuse me, Mr Prime Minister, you have several outstanding traffic summonses.

Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi found out yesterday that he had 11 traffic summonses against his official car and two cars, owned by him. Five of the

summonses were issued for speeding, four for traffic obstruction and two for parking on the wrong side.

Abdullah, who is also Internal Security Minister, said he was informed of the outstanding fines by the Deputy Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Musa Hassan. Sev-

eral Chinese newspapers reported the matter yesterday.

"Yes, I was informed of the matter. I will settle all the summonses on Monday.

"But before that, we will check on which car the summonses were issued to and who was driving it," he said.

Asked why the summonses were issued against the Prime Minister when the cars were registered under the Government, Musa too, seemed perplexed.

"The system is fully computerised. We will definitely look into who was driving the vehicles," Musa said.
