

PM sends sympathies to scalded hawker

IPOH: Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi has sent his sympathies to Chong Siew Lin over a freak incident, where the hawker was scalded by a pot of hot oil in Kampar on Sunday.

Chong's stall fell apart when hit by strong winds as one of the two helicopters carrying the Prime Minister and his entourage landed at a field next to

Kolej Tunku Abdul Rahman (KTAR) in Kampar.

She was scalded on her right arm and leg when the pot of oil in which she was frying *taufu* hit her.

Yesterday, Chong received RM2,000 from the Perak MCA and RM1,000 from Kampar MP Tan Sri Hew See Tong.
