

ACA may get report after probe

PUTRAJAYA: A report will be made with the Anti-Corruption Agency if a Public Works Department (PWD) probe confirms that funds for repairs at a Chinese school in Muar may have been misused.

A senior Education Ministry official said there would not be any internal investigations as the PWD had been ordered to look into the allegations.

The Cabinet, chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak, had given the order after it was told that about RM29,000 was approved for repairs at SJKC Kung Yu when the actual cost was only RM3,000.

Works Minister Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu had briefed the Cabinet following a recent visit to the school with Housing and Local Government Minister Datuk Seri Ong Ka Ting.
