

Please stop it, Rafidah tells *The Star* - (3/9/2006) Mahathir

KULIM: Datuk Seri Rafidah Aziz has made an impassioned plea to Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad to stop his personal attack on the Government and to work with the present administration to bring the country to a new level of development.

"I'm sure it is his personal wish to see this country achieve the objectives of Vision 2020 in good time," she said.

"And if Tun goes on like this, it will hamper this process.

"If Tun really loves the country and really wants to see the national agenda, the agenda of the Malays and the agenda of the multi-racial society of Malaysia realised in 2020, then he should help us," she said.

She made the plea after opening Infineon Technologies (Kulim) Sdn Bhd at Kulim Hi-Tech Park here yesterday.

The International Trade and Industry Minister said it would be better for Dr Mahathir to work with the Government and help it achieve Vision 2020.

"The less he talks the better, because some of (his allegations) are going to open a lot of unnecessary things which might even go back to his time (as prime minister)," she said.
