

# Drive on the spirit of the rakyat

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Malaysians should focus on promoting peace, harmony and progress in the country rather than on their differences.

In making this call, MCA Youth chairman Datuk Liow Tiong Lai said this was what made Malaysia a "progressive, farsighted and successful" nation in just 50 years.

"Let us continue to work together and not expend our energies debating on what we are as we are all already *rakyat* Malaysia," he said yesterday at

the launch of "The Spirit of Rakyat Malaysia" campaign at Wisma MCA here.
