

# 'Sad' that Khairy issue blown out of proportion

BANGI: Umno Youth chief Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein said it was "very sad" that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi had to deny that his son-in-law Khairy Jamaluddin was his adviser and was meddling in the country's administration.

"It is very sad indeed that the Prime Minister had to reply to the allegation. But, in the end, what is not true is not true," said Hishammuddin who blamed the allegation on irresponsible quarters.
