Nazri: No attempt to silence Dr M

KUALA LUMPUR: Former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad had attempted to discredit the current administration, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Mohd Nazri Abdul Aziz said.

In an interview with an Internet news portal, he also

refuted Dr Mahathir's allegation that the Government was trying to suppress his criticism over the decision to scrap the half-bridge project in Johor.

He said Dr Mahathir had gone beyond the line of criticism.

Commenting on remarks made by Dr Mahathir in an interview, Nazri said there was
